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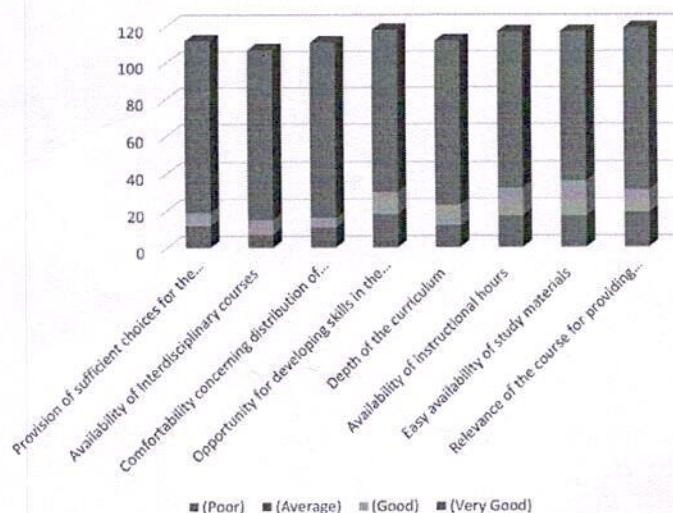
Action Taken Report on Curriculum Report for A.Y 2018-19

On taking the approval from the Governing body the College Academic committee of GITAMW has determined to follow the below mentioned action plan to improve in the suggested areas.

The feedback has been collected from stakeholders and prepared action plan. The possible Insights are implemented in accordance with JNTUA curriculum.

Students Feedback on Curriculum (2018-19)

The feedback on curriculum from students were obtained after the end of each academic session. Students opinion on syllabus were measured in a five-point scale (0-poor, 1-average, 2-Good, 3-Very Good, 4-Excellent). For analysis, a random sample of feedback of 116 students from all the Departments were selected with a proportional representation to each program. The data collected has been analysed and the results given below.



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Analysis of the feedback

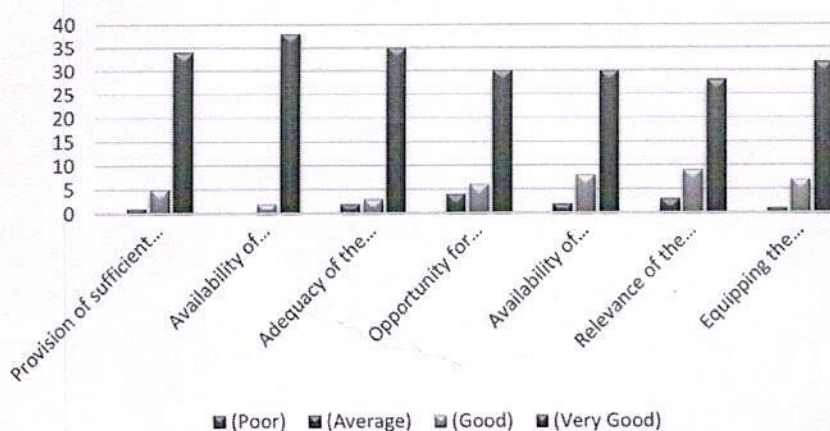
Analysis of the feedback shows that all the domains have been rated by the students to be excellent. The qualitative domain suggested that the students wanted more seminars and workshops to be arranged. They also wanted some short term courses. They also wanted classes specific for competitive exams and GATE. They also wanted hand on experience about how to handle interviews. They also demanded training and placement cell for various job opportunities. The students also asked for more internship programs.

Parent's Feedback on Curriculum(2018-19)

Analysis of the feedback

A graphical representation of feedback collected from parents for the year 2018-19. The feedback of the parents has improved from the beginning years as they rated the domains to be excellent. Parents suggested that in addition to the prescribed syllabus industrial visit, there is a growing need for the introduction of a training program or value-added course to improve the employability skills of students.

Parent feedback 2018-19



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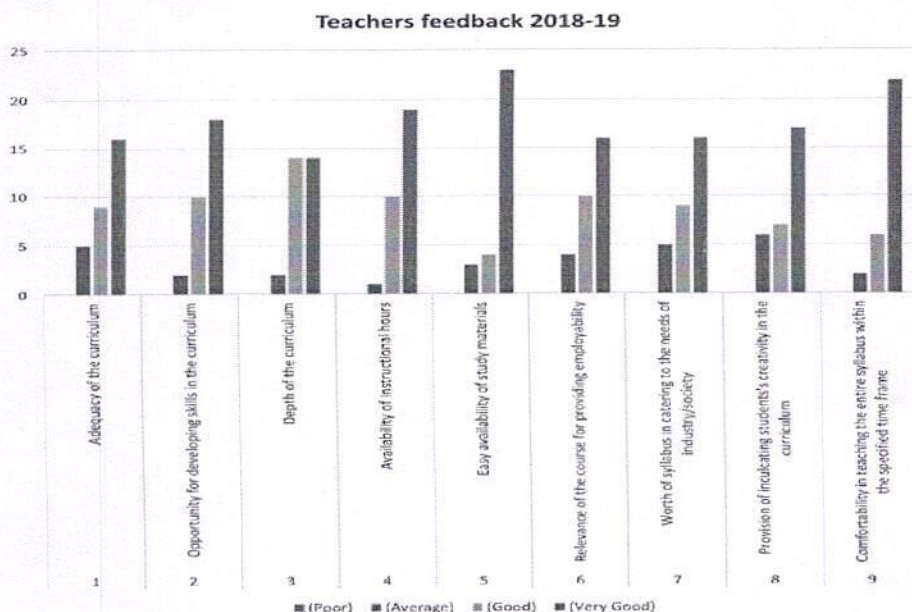


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Teacher's Feedback on Curriculum(2018-19)

Feedback from the teachers were collected and analyzed and has been represented graphically. The teacher's opinion curriculum were expressed in the feedback and that has been found to be excellent in every domain. The teachers of the GITAMW conducted workshops and had discussions with experts of their own discipline for improvement of the curriculum on aregular basis. They were also of the opinion to start some value added courses.



Action taken

The GITAMW CAC informed about the feedback. Necessary actions were initiated to start a training and placement cell. IQAC submitted the feedback report to Faculty council and council had asked all the departments to start value added courses in their programs to improve employability skills of students. As per the recommendation, various value- added courses were offered. All the departments were instructed to plan some value added courses in their respective program. The different suggestions regarding curriculum from different stakeholders were brought into the notice of GITAMW through proper channel.

Alumni feedback analysis

GITAMW incorporates alumni feedback to improve the quality of academic programs especially for design and review of syllabus. Feedback was obtained from alumni. The alumni rated all parameters: Provision of sufficient choices for the students in selecting courses, Availability of Opportunity for developing skills, Availability of instructional hours, Easy availability of study materials, Relevance of the course for providing employability, Worth of syllabus in catering to the needs of industry/society, Equipping the students for higher studies, Alumni feel proud to be the

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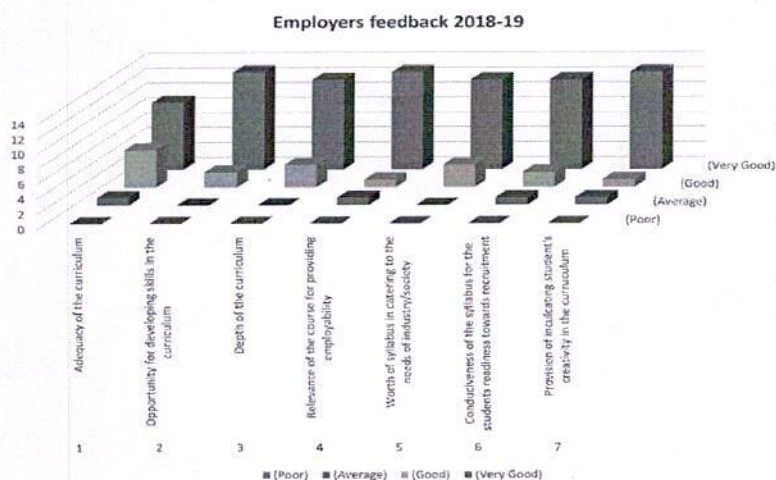
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student of GITAMW. Alumni were appreciated the introduction of CBCS as according to them that has increased the scope of interdisciplinary discussion. They were also all praise for the digitalization of the library services and examination process. The pass out students were well impressed with the developments in the GITAMW in recent years. The alumni have also appreciated the cooperativeness of faculty members. The alumni unanimously wanted a formal central/departmental alumni association to be formed. A similar percentage of alumni opined that department administration should take initiative to efficiently enroll and strengthen the alumni-association. The learning received in the GITAMW was found useful by alumni in their career. Similar to current students, alumni were also acknowledged the excellent knowledge of faculty members. The fee structure was rated as very nominal.

The alumni members also requested if some short term certificate or skill development courses may be started out of the working hours so that they can also get benefitted from the course.

Employers' feedback on the curriculum



It was found that all the employers rated the parameters as either very good or excellent. According to the employers The GITAMW students were very good in their relationship with seniors/peers/subordinates. They also praised their technical knowledge/skill. Employers highly appreciated their ability to take up extra responsibility. Other promising features that were pointed out by the employers were general communication skill, ability to contribute to the goal of the organization, obligation to work beyond schedule if required, working as part of a team, self-motivated and taking on appropriate level of responsibility, and open to new ideas and learning new techniques. Overall the employers were very much willing to recruit our students in their esteemed organizations and were also willing to collaborate with the GITAMW.

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
Action Taken Report on Curriculum Feedback for A.Y 2020-21

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

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
